Security at Cropland

Our in-house data protection officer established different types of protection, meaning your data are in safe hands. We opted to install an in-house specialist instead of outsourcing this task. In-house protections adds to the security of your data, and ensures quick actions. The central management also ensures that eventual data breaches are noticed within minutes so that appropriate actions can be taken.

Whenever you decide to start up a project with our team, we make a separate workspace in our cloud for your company projects. Only team members involved in your project are granted access to this workspace.

In the case of termination of employment of a team member, access will immediately be revoked. Above this, accessing particular data and databases is continuously logged. All analyses in our cloud require two-factor authentication.

Your project

All data associated with your project or company are being saved on encrypted volumes. Every computer, laptop or other data carrier is encrypted, meaning that in case of theft, access to the data is not possible. The only way to access the computer, laptop or data carrier is erasing all of its contents, including the data associated with your company.

Privacy and GDPR

As Cropland operates in the EU, we are obliged to process all incoming personal data following the General Data Protection Regulation. As a result, every client or website visitor has different rights regarding personal data saved by Cropland. These rights include, but are not limited to, the right to access to your data, the right to alter your data, the right to be forgotten and the right of transferability.
